What is the Septic Assistance Program?

The Septic System Assistance Program provides cash assistance to those who live within the Holly Drain Watershed in Shiawassee County to repair or replace your home septic system (see map below).

How much financial benefits are provided?

This program will cover 75% of the costs to pump a home septic tank and 75% of the costs to replace a failing septic system.

Who can apply?

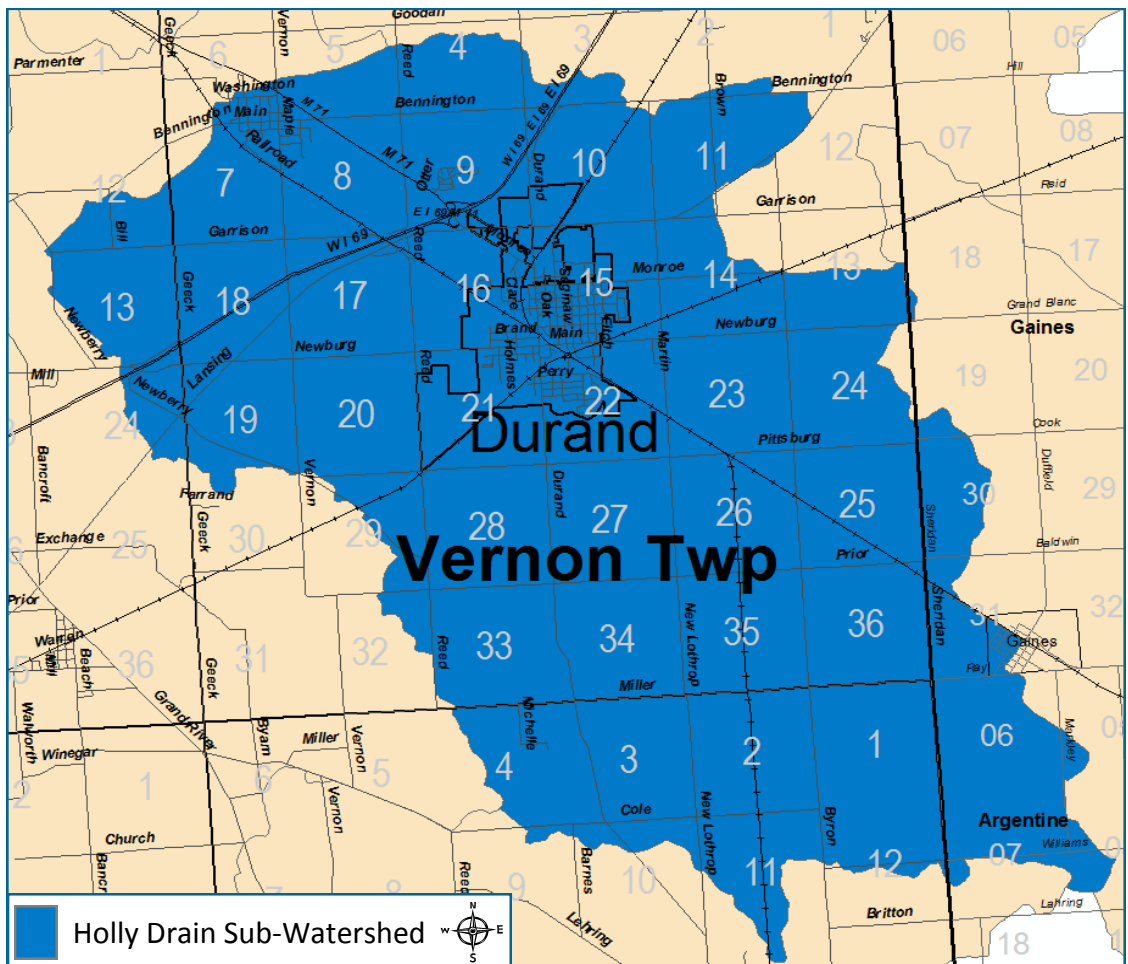
This program is open to homeowners who live in the Holly Drain Watershed in Shiawassee County.
